



## Entry Requirements

Please make sure that you fulfill the entry requirements for each port of your cruise.

Your Passport has to be valid at least 6 months after the end of your voyage for all countries, independent from the destination. Please also make sure that you have enough free pages in your passport available.

The following entry requirements are relevant for **Danish citizens**:

<b>Gambia</b>	On Arrival	Free of charge for up to 90 days
<b>Ghana</b>	onboard	Fee of approx. 20,00 \$

<b>Indonesia</b>	On Arrival	Fee of approx. 25,00 \$

<b>Canada</b>	Online	<a href="http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp">http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp</a> Starting Autumn 2016 an entry permit will be requested when arriving by air. For entering the country by sea or land, no ETA is necessary.
<b>Cambodia</b>	onboard	Fee of approx. 55,00 \$
<b>Cape Verde</b>	On Arrival	Fee of approx. 25-30 EUR
<b>Madagascar</b>	On Arrival	Free of charge
<b>Maldives</b>	On Arrival	Free of charge

<b>Papua-New Guinea</b>	On Arrival	Free of charge
<b>Russian Federation</b>	At the embassy	When participating in a shore excursion booked via Princess Cruises, the visa is included. If you go on your own, you need to apply for a visa. <a href="http://denmark.kdmid.ru/en.aspx">http://denmark.kdmid.ru/en.aspx</a>
<b>Solomone Islands</b>	On Arrival	Free of charge
<b>Sao Tomé</b>	onboard	Fee of approx. 30,00 \$

<b>Togo</b>	On Arrival	Fee of approx. 30 USD /visa can be obtained in advance as well
<b>USA</b>	Online	<a href="https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/">https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/</a> The dates of birth should be advised to the airline. Travelers with double citizenship (one of which from Iraq, Iran, Syria or Sudan), as well as travelers who have visited above countries after 01.03.2011, need a visa.
<b>USA Transit</b>	Online	ESTA is required as soon as you enter the US. Even if you just have a connection flight via an US airport (transit)
<b>UAE</b>	On Arrival	Free of charge

- Travellers under 21 years:
  - \*For tourists under 21 travelling alone, there are specific entry requirements for each country. We kindly ask you to contact the embassy/consulate for specific information.
  - \*For underaged travellers with a family name different than their parents', a proof of family relation is required (e.g. a birth certificate).

**We recommend all passengers to carry a copy of their passport with them at all times.**

**Please make sure you have all current information about vaccinations as well. E.g. a Yellow Fever vaccination is required at some ports in Africa and South America.**
